Eurovent and FAIAR sign Memorandum of Understanding

Organisations join forces to level the playing field in the HVACR sector

Brussels, Bogotá, 23 June 2021. Eurovent and the Federation of Ibero-American Air Conditioning and Refrigeration Associations (FAIAR) signed a Memorandum of Understanding, underlining their commitment to greater harmonisation and stronger ties between Europe and Latin America.

In the framework of the Memorandum, the two organisations will collaborate on standards development, codes of good practice and networking events, among others. Eurovent and FAIAR will have their first high-level coordination meeting still this year to identify concrete opportunities for joint action.
